Priorities of Ministry of Environment



Circular Economy - including waste package, with aim to:

- divert waste from landfilling (2016, Eurostat: SK municipal waste 348 kg per capita/landfilled 228 kg, i.e. 65,5%)
- increase material recovery (2014, Eurostat: SK circular material use rate 4,8% NL 26,7%)
- increase recycling rate of municipal waste (Eurostat: SK 2016 23%, 2015 14,9% 2014 10,3%)

- Waste Act amendment, January 1, 2019
- Legislative proposal to increase landfill fees for municipalities - gradual increase from 2019 based on the level of separation
